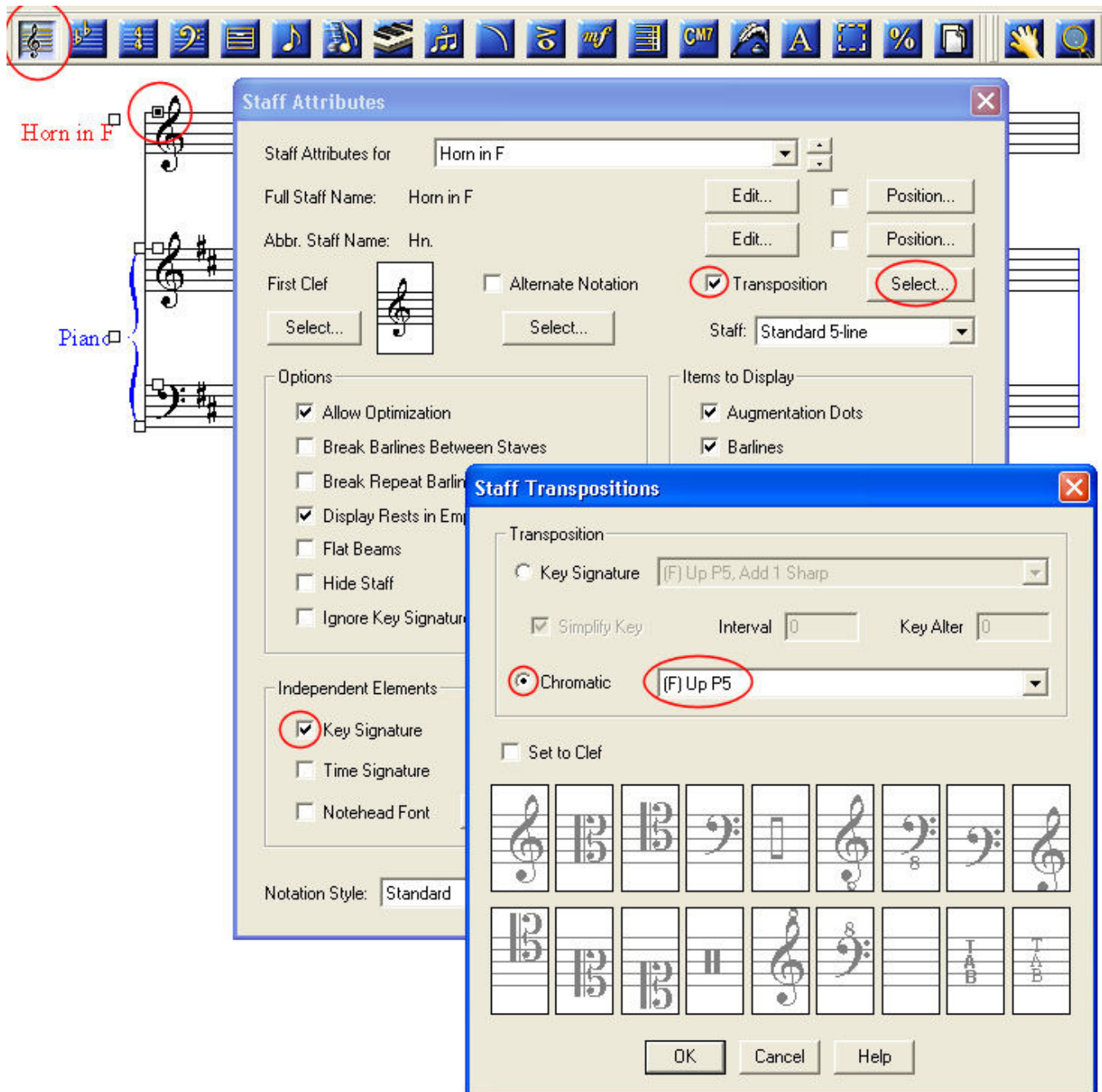


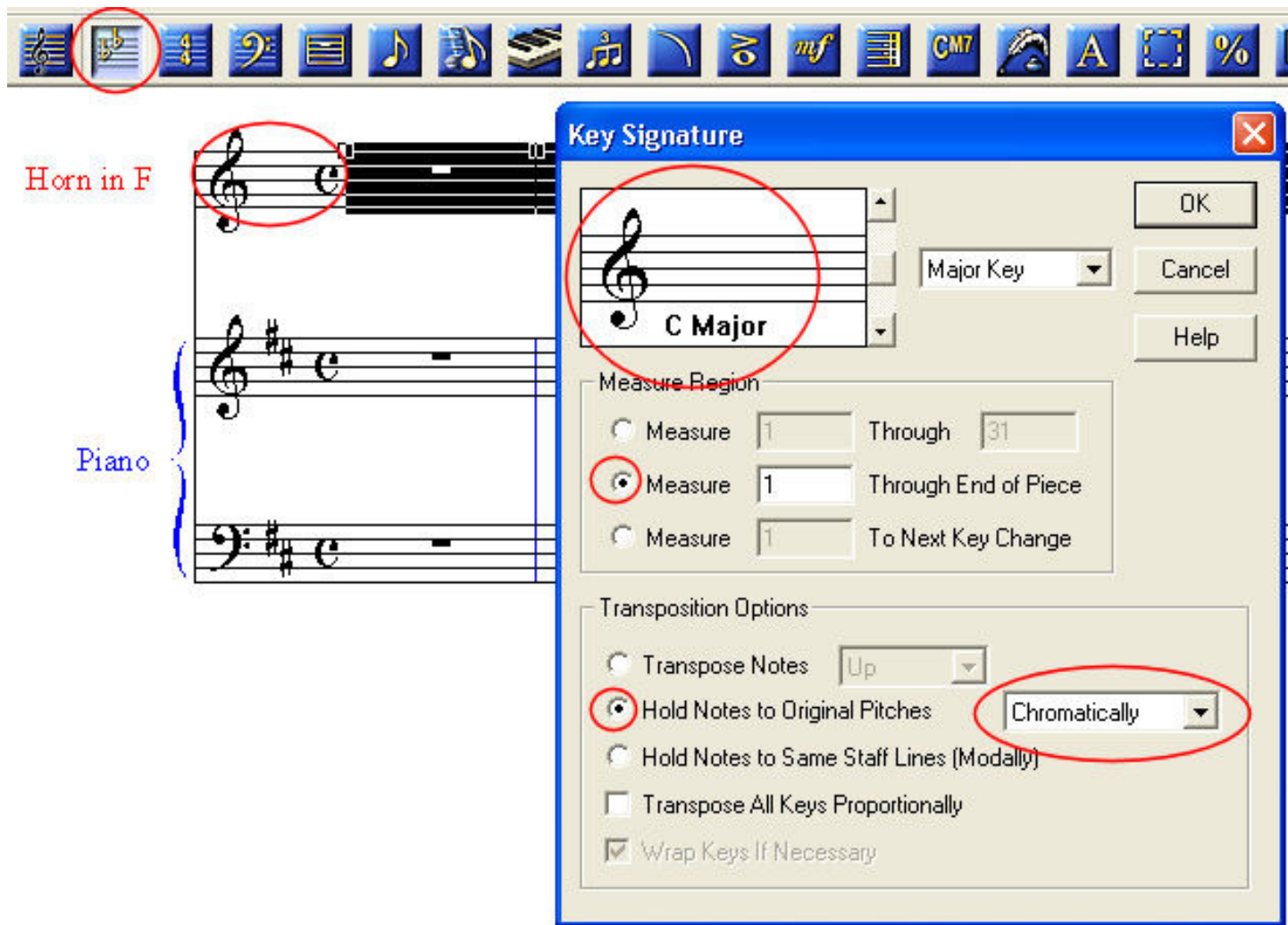
Horn in F With No Key Signature

Here's how to create an F horn staff with no key signature. Flats or sharps appear as accidentals. Playback will be correct. (The same technique can of course be applied to Bb Trumpet, Timpani, etc.)

1. Create the horn staff with the Staff Tool or wizard.
2. From the Staff Tool, double-click the handle on the horn staff.
 - a. Check "Independent Elements: Key Signature"
 - b. Check "Transposition"
 - c. Click "Transposition: Select..." In the resulting dialog, choose "Chromatic: (F) Up P5"
 - d. Close both dialogs with "OK"



3. From the Key Signature tool, double-click on the Horn staff.
 - a. Pick C Major (no flats or sharps)
 - b. In Measure Region, select the entire piece.
 - c. If you have already entered correct pitches into the staff, select “Hold Notes to Original Pitches Chromatically)
 - d. Close the dialog with OK



4. You may now enter notes in the horn staff. Flats or sharps will appear as accidentals.
